DWIGHT SCHOOL STUDENTS FROM ACROSS THE GLOBE SHOWCASE MUSICAL ACHIEVEMENTS AT CARNEGIE HALL

WHAT: For the first time, [Dwight School](http://www.dwight.edu) — an internationally renowned educator of the next generation of innovative global leaders — is assembling students from its campuses in London and Seoul to join those from New York in the School's annual concert at Carnegie Hall. The concert, entitled "*Tutti*," an Italian word meaning "altogether," will celebrate the collective musical talents of Dwight's international student body. It will feature music of all genres performed by choirs, instrumental ensembles, and solo performances by 200 students, representing 40 countries, and ranging from 4th to 12th grade. Highlights include:

- A solo by seasoned concert violinist Elli Choi '20, a Juilliard Pre-college Division student
- An original composition by Andrew Abrahamsen '14
- A rousing all-voices and all-musician finale
